Networking Reception

The Port of the Future Student Research Poster Contest

The Port of the Future Conference will host its 2025 Student Research Poster Contest, an opportunity for undergraduate students worldwide to contribute to research in the port and maritime domains, gain professional recognition, and begin to build a network of like-minded colleagues and mentors. Quad charts of this research will be posted through the hallways of the Conference. An award ceremony to recognize top research submissions will be held on the evening of Tuesday, April 1st at 6:30 pm in the Conrad Hilton Ballroom.

Port Endeavor Exercise

The Port of the Future Conference has contracted with two facilitators from the International Association of Ports and Harbors to conduct the Port Endeavor Exercise on Thursday afternoon, April 3^{rd} with the possibility of additional iterations on April 4^{th} .

The Port Endeavor Exercise is a 3-hour workshop (introduction, gameplay, extended debrief and discussions) that uses an interactive board game to help port representatives integrate UN Sustainability Development Goals into their business strategy and day-to-day operations. It is designed to train and increase awareness amongst ports, their users, and their communities as to what roles they can play to deal with the environmental, social and economic challenges facing the industry.
